



LLRCrew Damage Policy

All damage to any LLRCrew and private equipment must be reported to the head coach within 24 hours of the incident. This excludes minor scratches that do not compromise the integrity of the hull. Damage should be reported on the Equipment Log Form on the clipboard in the bin.

Equipment is defined as follows:

- Boats and boat hardware
- Oars
- Launches
- Boat racks
- LLRC dock
- LLRC Trailer

Avoidable Damage is defined as follows:

- Damage caused by hitting a buoy, bridge, dock or other fixed object.
- Damaged caused by hitting another boat while rowing against the traffic pattern.
- Damage caused by falling into or stepping into a shell, either in the water or dry-docked

Assessments for Avoidable Damage:

- The head coach will ask LLRCrew Treasurer to assess each Crew participant involved in an Avoidable Damage incident the cost to repair the damage, to be evenly divided, but not to exceed \$150 per Crew participant.
- An assessment of damage will be determined by the head coach.
- A request for review may be directed to the board of directors.
